Course Description

This interprofessional education (IPE) course is designed for students in dentistry, medicine, nursing, pharmacy, and social work. The course allows health professional students to gain an understanding of how each discipline contributes to the healthcare team and the importance of effective communication and team collaboration to clinical decision making. 2 credits. Students will work in interprofessional teams and rotate through modules taught at all five schools by interdisciplinary pairs of faculty.
