Hi P1s, P2s, and 3s:

Here is today's daily summary for you:

1. While there were a few bumps along the way, we made it through our first day of remote learning. Thanks to everyone for their patience. **Check your course Canvas sites to stay informed about how each course will be offered remotely.** Faculty have been instructed to keep information on their Canvas site current. We expect some of the initial plans may need to be adjusted.
2. We created a [google doc](#) on the college website where you can **report online/remote learning concerns**. Please scan the list before reporting something so we don't get multiple reports of the same problem with a given class. College administration will review this document at least twice daily.
3. Any student who is **leaving the local area must submit an absence request** so the college has a record of who is around. We are using the absence system as a way of tracking students during this time.
4. If you are **ill and can't participate in a synchronous (live) remote class session**, you should submit an absence request just as you would have if absent from a live class session prior to the campus shut down.
5. Students who leave the local area are expected to participate in **remote synchronous (live) teaching** conducted during the usual scheduled time.
6. **Exams will be given during the time noted on the exam calendar** for any student located in the US/Canada. Those moving to other time zones should plan accordingly. Students moving outside the US must work with Student Services who will coordinate with the course coordinator.
7. **Students who wish to pause their IPPEs** should look for the form sent from Dean Walker through CORE ELMS. Note that APPEs cannot start until all IPPE hours have been completed (we received confirmation of this from ACPE today).
8. Be sure to be in **contact with your PDI advisor** if your research requires IRB approval or involves contact with human subjects.
