The following usage updates have been changed With Gov. Gretchen Whitmer's announcement to rescind the Stay Home, Stay Safe order and President Schlissel's [message](#) addressing how the university will continue our gradual reactivation, we are providing updates pertaining to COVID-19 paid time off and a resource to support recalling employees from the voluntary furlough program.

Changes have been made to the UHR COVID-19 Paid Time Off [webpage](#) that compares the various paid time off options. The updates are described below:

Federal Emergency Paid Sick Leave (EPSLA)

For employees who are unable to work remotely, EPSLA is only available for use until June 7, 2020.

*Does not apply to those that are able to work remotely and are supplementing time due to the closure of school/daycare.

U-M COVID-19 Paid Time Off

Employees hired after June 7, 2020, are not eligible for this one-time bank of paid time off.

Short Term Sick

For employees who are unable to work remotely, short-term sick is only available for use until June 7, 2020. Use of short-term sick for employees caring for a child whose school or daycare is closed remains available.
