## **Today's Commencement Speaker**



KRISTEN FLAHARTY, PHARMD '87
Founder and CEO, Trilogy Laboratories

Dr. Kristen Flaharty, a board-certified clinical pharmacologist, earned her Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Michigan, followed by a clinical residency at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital and a research fellowship in clinical pharmacology at Jefferson Medical College. She has held assistant professor positions at the University of Utah and Nova Southeastern College of Pharmacy, where she taught and conducted research. Dr. Flaharty has published numerous

scientific articles and presented at many professional meetings.

Much of her career has been devoted to clinical research and development with a focus on regulatory strategy in the pharmaceutical industry. She played a significant role in bringing more than 20 prescription drugs to market in the US and worldwide and holds a patent on combination therapy for inhibition of platelet aggregation.

After working in the pharmaceutical industry, she founded Trilogy Laboratories in 2014, a company dedicated to formulating and manufacturing small-batch, high-quality, medical-grade skincare products for physicians, estheticians and small-to-medium-sized beauty brands worldwide. Her company has received several industry accolades, including Small Manufacturer of the Year, Florida Companies to Watch and has been recently named a top 10 Global Private Label Manufacturer.

In addition to being a successful business owner, Dr. Flaharty is active in her community, chairing hospital Institutional Review Boards, serving on Canterbury School's Board of Trustees, supporting STEM education for local students and mentoring future professionals. She also hosts educational events at her lab. Her philanthropic interests include education and science and she and her husband have endowed a scholarship for Michigan Medicine students.

#### MUSTAPHA BELEH, PHD

Frank J. Ascione Collegiate Teaching Professor of Medicinal Chemistry

Dr. Mustapha Beleh earned his BS in Pharmacy from Alexandria University and a PhD in Medicinal Chemistry from The Ohio State University. His career spans roles in hospital and community pharmacy, pharmaceutical research and academia. He is currently a Teaching Professor and Director of Education at the University of Michigan.

Dr. Beleh is deeply involved in teaching and mentoring PharmD and undergraduate students, coordinating the Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacology course sequence. His research focuses on the scholarship of teaching and advancements in pharmaceutical education.

He has received numerous awards, including being a two-time recipient of the College of Pharmacy's Teaching Excellence Award (2019, 2025), Teacher of the Year and the Dean's Award for Excellence in Teaching at South Dakota State University, as well as the Golden Apple Award, and special recognition for teaching at the University of Michigan. He has also received multiple student appreciation awards.

Additionally, Dr. Beleh is a Computerworld Honors Laureate and a finalist for the 21st Century Achievement Award from the Smithsonian.
